6802/ May/ 06 The Mayor's Address

The Mayor, Cllr Colin Jenkins congratulated the Committee of the Civic Hall for making the Hall such an active place for the Community. He gave a record of all the events and functions attended on behalf of the Council. He thanked all the Charity organisations in the Town for all their hard work, in particular the Tenovus Group for raising over £20000. He spoke of the Council's achievements during the year, high lighting the Heritage Project, being successful in securing funding for a project that would promote Tourism in the Town. Finally, Station Road was being resurfaced after years of campaigning. The next year would be an exciting one as the Council, prepared to undertake another project in conjunction with Cambria to upgrade the Shire Hall. This would make all the Historical records of Carmarthenshire available to the public. He closed by thanking all the local Mayors for their fellowship during the year.

6803 / May/ 06 Nomination for Mayor 2006-7

The Civic Hall was an excellent example of a project which was Community owned and Community led. Bookings this year were up by 30%. 27000 people had used the Hall over the past year. More refurbishments were due to take place and the Town Council were very glad to support the hard working committee financially to enable these to be completed.
