Mr Ian Jones , acting Head of Leisure and Sport for Carmarthenshire County Council addressed the Council at the invitation of the Mayor. He explained the issues surrounding the provision of a new Public Swimming Pool at Tregib School. The delays caused by having to consult with the Brecon Beacons National Park Authority in particular, coupled with new regulations imposed by the Environment Agency had more than doubled the costs. Monthly Project Group meetings were taking place under the Chair of the School, Mrs Griffiths. Mr Jones promised to keep the Council aware of any developments. The Mayor thanked him for his comprehensive report.

**Police Matters :** The Mayor gave a verbal report on behalf of Sergeant Neil Jones. Inspector Ward would attend the March Planning meeting to report on the progress of the Neighbourhood Policing Policy.

**6686 / Jan / 06 Previous Minutes**

The Minutes of the Full meeting held in the Shire Hall on Wednesday, 14<sup>th</sup> December, 2005 were approved and signed as a true and accurate record. Proposed by Cllr Ieuan Gwyn and seconded by Cllr Richard Wallace. All were in favour.

The Minutes of the Planning Committee meeting held at the Shire Hall on January 11<sup>th</sup>, 2006 were read and approved as a correct record. Proposed by Cllr Fran Murphy and seconded by Cllr Richard Wallace. All were in favour

The Minutes of the Finance Committee meeting held at the Shire Hall on Wednesday January 11<sup>th</sup>, 2006 were read and confirmed as a true record . Proposed by Cllr Hugh Towns and seconded by Cllr Ieuan Gwyn. All were in favour.

## **6688 / Jan / 06 Financial Matters.**

### 1. Accounts for Payment.

- a) Cambria Archaeological Trust staged payment for Heritage Scheme Work , invoice for 80% of cost £19308.00  
Proposed by Cllr Hugh Towns and seconded by Cllr Ros Bellamy

- b) Dyfed Tree Care in respect of work at The Crescent Road Allotment £260.00  
Proposed by Cllr Colin Jenkins and seconded by Cllr Hugh Towns.  
All in favour.
- c) Mr Des Davies, in respect of IT computer Course £ 46.00  
Proposed by Cllr Hugh Towns and seconded by Cllr Ieuan Gwyn  
All in favour.

2. Repair to Shire Hall Chimney. The Technical Officer reported that he had received an estimate for £450 for erection of scaffolding to allow for the inspection of the chimney. It was also estimated that the labour costs of the inspection would be in the region of £200 to include a report.Cllr Ros Bellamy proposed that this be accepted and Cllr Richard Wallace seconded. All were in favour.

2. Glynceirch Footpath. The Financial Officer recommended that as the repair work necessary would involve heavy machinery, that the work be left until April , so that less damage could be caused to the farmer’s land.Cllr Hugh Towns in proposing that this be accepted, also proposed that the budget for footpaths be carried forward to the next financial year. Cllr Ieuan Gwyn seconded the proposal. All were in favour.

## **6689 / Jan / 06 Mayor’s Report**

The Mayor ,Cllr Colin Jenkins gave a report of all the meetings and functions attended on behalf of the council during the month.

## **6690 / Jan / 06 The Heritage – Town Trail Project**

Cllr Ros Bellamy reported the working party had held a series of meetings with Cambria and County Cllr Ieuan Jones. Cambria were happy to work with the content and themes of the plaques. An example of one of the plaques was shown at the meeting.

### **6691 / Jan / 06 The Garden Project**

The Mayor thanked all the Councillors and people who had helped clear the Allotment over the Christmas period

Cllr Pam Steane Price presented a comprehensive report of the work carried out to date. Some 200 hours of work had been carried out by volunteers. The Clerk was asked to send a letter of thanks to Mr Ken Murphy for carrying out a full survey on the allotment for the Council. The Clerk was asked to file all reports. The next volunteer day would be on Saturday February 4<sup>th</sup>, at 9.30am. Cllr Steane Price proposed that the Council join the Federation of City Farms and Gardens. This was seconded by Cllr Ros Bellamy. All were in favour.

### **6692 / Jan / 06 Website**

Cllr Pam Steane Price proposed that the Council pay for the next three month licence fee for the website at a cost of £5. Cllr Charlotte Leadbeater seconded. All were in favour.

### **6693 / Jan / 06 Delegated Powers to Committees**

Cllr Hugh Towns proposed that the Council reviews its procedures and the documents that it produces. A subcommittee consisting of Cllr Towns, Cllr Ieuan Gwyn and Cllr Richard Wallace would carry out the review and report back by the end of May 2006. This was seconded by Cllr Colin Jenkins. All were in favour.

### **6694 / Jan / 06 – Correspondence**

1. Letter from Mr DA Jones. – Clerk was asked to reply apologising for not informing him of the Council's actions following a previous letter.  
It was reiterated that a standard letter of acknowledgement be sent to all senders.
