4. Three Year Budget Forecast

The Finance Officer circulated the forecasts to date. He informed the Council that although £ 82,000 had been budgeted for the year there was an underspend at present of £ 22,000. There was an amount of £8465 to be rolled over to 2008-9 due to on going commitments As the Gwyl Llandeilo was not going to take place, it was agreed to transfer this to the Penlan Park Centenary Celebrations. It was also decided to transfer £1000 from the reserves to act as a contingency for the Park events.

5. The renovations to the Council benches and table.

The contractor carrying out the renovations to these reported that the fixing bolts needed to be replaced at a cost of £52 to include labour. The two new seats chosen to replace the defective seats were to cost £717.15 each. They were Stanford seats with brown Enviro poly slatted by Glasdon. One new seat was to be positioned at the entrance to Penlan park and the other in Bradford Square Cllr Ros Bellamy proposed that these prices be accepted. Cllr Edward Thomas seconded. All were in favour. The cost of fixing the new seats would be £100 for each one. Cllr Hugh Towns proposed that this quotation be accepted. Cllr Christopher Parish seconded. All were in favour.

- 1.Cllr Ros Bellamy advised the Council that a shield and centres bearing the Town crest had been ordered for the presentation to pupils of Tregib school at the annual prize evening as agreed previously. There were 6 prize winners each to receive £60. It was proposed by Cllr Edward Thomas and seconded by Cllr Hugh Towns that this total sum of £360 be paid. All were in favour.
- 2. The Technical Officer had received a quotation from C& M Bacon to repair the Shire Hall clock. This was £300 with an extra £25 if there was need to change the main spring. Cllr Colin Jenkins proposed that the work be approved. This was seconded by Cllr Hugh Towns. All were in favour.
- 3. CCC Local Project Fund. Confirmation that County Cllr Ieuan Jones had donated £400 towards the Centenary Celebrations of the opening of Penlan park
