**Min 286 / Mar / 15 To Discuss the position regarding the Asset Transfer of some public facilities in Llandeilo.**

The Council had invited Emily Thomas of the CCC Asset Transfer Team and Paul Murray, CCC Parks Manager to the meeting to provide information to the Council. Councillors raised a significant number of issues with the CCC representatives .

Emily Thomas stated that at present CCC were prepared to offer up to £10,000 as a grant to carry out approved improvements on the areas under discussion, i.e. Penlan Park and Parc Le Conquet. The County Council would also offer twice the annual current maintenance costs as an initial payment.

Paul Murray stated that the Carmarthenshire County Bowls Association was negotiating as a single body to secure certain bowling rinks in the County at an agreed maintenance rate.

Mr Murray was hopeful that football clubs in the County would also negotiate collectively through their various league associations.

The CCC representatives agreed to consider further some of the issues raised by the members and return to meet again with the Council.

Emily Thomas stated that there had to be a procedure to follow if the Council decides to make an Expression of Interest. The final date for the Town Council to consider its position was June 2016.
