Min 86 / June / 16 Other Financial Matters

1. Three Year Budget Forecast. The Finance Officer reported that the Staff had been awarded a pay rise through the National Pay Body, and he would bring the financial implications back to Council next month. He also stated that the new Pay & Pensions directive would also have an impact during this year.

2. Audit 2015/6.

The Finance Officer reported that the Internal Auditor had completed his part of the Audit and there were no issues to be brought to the attention of the Council. The period of the inspection begins on June 10th and all documents to be sent to the External Auditor by 11th July. Cllr Eifion Davies proposed a vote of thanks to Mr Plummer for all his work.

2. Requests for financial Support

a) Llandeilo Festival of Music 2016.

Cllr Richard Wallace proposed that the budgeted amount of £3,500 be donated to support this year's Festival. Cllr Gordon Kilby seconded. All were in favour.

Min 87 / June /16 Finance Related Correspondence.

1. Menter Bro Dinefwr. Letter requesting donations for the first Ras yr Iaeth taking place around the Dinefwr Area to promote and celebrate the Welsh Language. This will take place on Friday , July 8th . The Llandeilo Race will finish at Home Farm.

It was proposed by Cllr Edward Thomas that the Council donate £100 to the event. Cllr Gordon Kilby seconded. All were in favour.
