This had been another successful event. The only issue to take on board for next year was to make sure that no stewards were drinking alcohol when on duty. Cllr Geraint Price had purchased 4 counters which had greatly helped with the entry number count. Special thanks were recorded for Cllr Geraint Price's work prior to the event.

Pendragon had already been booked for the 2017 event. It was recommended that the firework order be increased to £4,500 next year.

It was recommended that 2 speakers be purchased at a cost of £ 300.00 from this year's budget. The following donations were agreed:-

Finally it was recommended a programme be produced next year and that the budget for next year remain at £ 6,500.
