Minutes of the Full Council Meeting of Llandeilo Town Council held on Wednesday, November 23rd 2016 in the Shire Hall, Llandeilo at 7.30 pm.

Police Matters.

PCSO Roger Anthony reported there had been a theft at the Cawdor Hotel. A person has been arrested. There had been a burglary at CKs supermarket carried out by travellers who had also stolen from a shop in Llandovery. A few car mirrors had been damaged in Carmarthen Road. PCSO Anthony reported that the Festival of Senses had gone well Cllr Geraint Price asked if the Police could send officers to advise shopkeepers to review their security systems in view of recent incidents. PCSO Anthony agreed to request this from his senior officers.
