Police Matters.

PCSO Louise Lewis stated that she had spoken to the Dentist staff and the owner of a vehicle regarding parking outside the Cennen Dental Practice. The Police would continue to carry out observations in Rhosmaen Street to ensure there would be no obstruction of the pavement. There were on-going problems with a tenant in Bro Hywel. A person had been arrested, charged and bailed following an attempted burglary at Bro Hywel.

Min 279/ Feb / 16 The County Councillor's Report

Cllr Edward Thomas had circulated his report in advance of the Meeting. Cllr Thomas had met with the Head teacher of the Primary School and PCSO Louise Lewis to observe the flow of traffic outside the school. There were on-going problems of cars parking outside the schools. Complaints regarding fly tipping in Heol y Garreg Las have been reported to CCC.

Min 281 / Feb / 16 Matters arising from previous meetings

Re. Min 249/ Jan / 16 Cllr Edward Thomas stated with regard to the old Tregib school site, that CCC at the present time ,did not have an alternative site for the proposed new Primary school.

Re. Min 256 / Jan / 16 Cllr Edward Thomas proposed that the Council make an interim payment of £1,000 to the Public Hall committee to carry out urgent repairs with the remainder of the £2,000 agreed donation to be taken from the 2016/ 17 budget. Cllr Rob Jones seconded. There were 5 votes in favour, 1 Member was against and 1 Member did not vote. The Proposal was carried.

Re Min 273/ Feb/16 (.2) Cllr Edward Thomas recommended that the Finance Committee review the possibility of making further donations to the Llandeilo First Responders at its next Meeting. Cllr Robert Jones seconded. All were in favour.
