Minutes of the Full Council Meeting of Llandeilo Town Council held on Wednesday, April 27th 2016 in the Shire Hall, Llandeilo at 7.30 pm.

Police Matters.

PCSO Roger Anthony reported that the burger van had been broken into twice. A person had been arrested and charged. A window in George Street had been damaged late one evening. A local man had been arrested for the offence. One of the Traffic Wardens had been threatened in Crescent Road and the culprit identified. A person from Neath now living in Bro Hywel continued to create problems in the Town and had been banned from all Pubs and shops. Some people moving into the Town and occupying private flats were also reported as causing problems. PCSO Anthony wished to all to be aware of the scheme set up by him called ' Cuppa with a Copper' was being held each first Thursday of each month in Maes Elfryn.

Min 17 / Apr / 16 The County Councillor's Report

Cllr Edward Thomas had circulated his report in advance of the Meeting. Cllr Thomas stated that CCC were to carry out a survey of car parking charges in the County. Cllr Thomas was to check on present anomalies on charges in different areas and report back at the earliest opportunity. The planters in Bridge Street are soon to be replanted for the summer.
