**Min 5 / April / 19 The Technical Officer's Report**

**Min 7 / April / 19 Correspondence**

1. An application had been received by CCC from Gin Haus to amend the conditions of their current premises licence. It was proposed by Cllr Christoph Fischer, seconded by Cllr Robert Jones that the Council support the licence application. This was carried with 4 votes in favour and 1 vote against.

2. Institute of Welsh Affairs re. Proposed website- Understanding Welsh Places.  
It was proposed by Cllr Colin Jenkins, seconded by Cllr Dawn Wallace that this be forwarded to Ken Murphy for his advice . All were in favour.
3. CCC Draft Local Toilets Strategy.

4. Superintendent Gary Mills response to the letter sent to him from the Mayor Cllr Edward Thomas re. changes to policing in Llandeilo.  
It was proposed by Cllr Robert Jones, seconded by Cllr Dawn Wallace that the Clerk shall reply with the following questions :-
  - i) Will the current PCSO be replaced following his retirement ?
  - ii) How will the Police inform the public of the changes ?
  - iii) When will the changes come into operation ?The Clerk will also state that the Council will ask for feedback from the residents of Llandeilo as to whether the changes have caused more inconvenience. Noted
